

Service Learning Experience Grant Application College of Education & Human Development

The College of Education and Human Development is pleased to announce a new Service Learning Experience Grant. Consistent with the College's Strategic Vision and the University's Aggies Commit to Learning for a Lifetime initiatives, the objective of this grant is to facilitate high impact learning experiences across the four departments for faculty and students. These service learning experiences should combine community service and engagement with education and reflection. Expected learning outcomes build on the College's targeted QEP learning outcomes: ability to work collaboratively, demonstration of social, cultural, and global competence, and mastery of depth of knowledge required for a degree. Faculty members and student organizations working with a faculty advisor on a new or existing project are eligible to apply.

Awardees will be granted funds to defray the cost of supplies needed to carry out the service learning project. Recipients of the grant, including all members of the participating student organization, must compose and submit a reflection to the faculty advisor and the CEHD Office of Academic Affairs within one year of the award.

To apply for the grant, submit the completed form (see attached) by September 1, 2016 for projects that will be starting in the fall, or November 30, 2016 for projects planned for the spring, to Ms. Kristy Anderson (kanderson@tamu.edu). Grant monies will be distributed, as they are available.
